

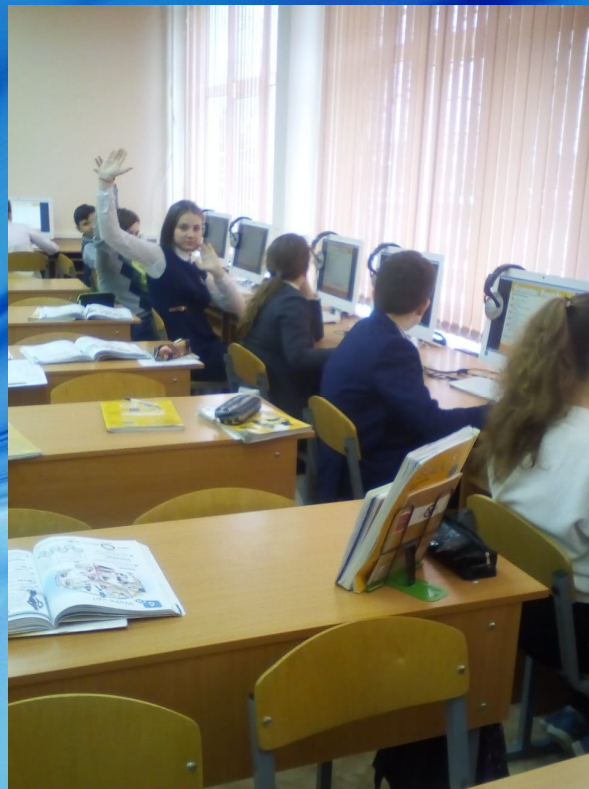
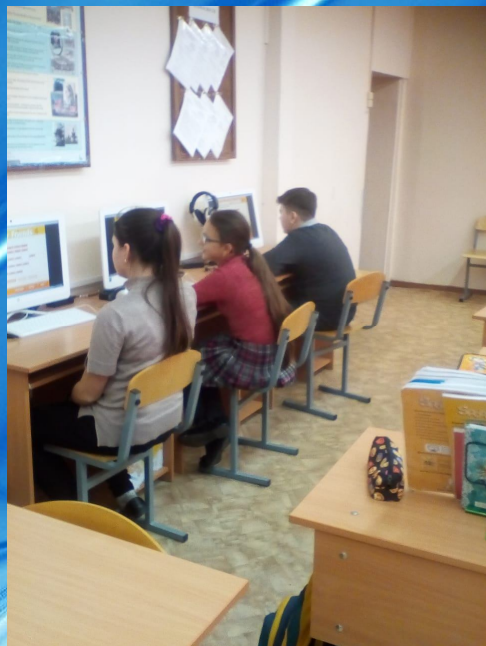

## Образование утвердительного предложения

“+” S+V/Vs.

например: **I swim.** - Я плаваю.

**You swim.** – Ты плаваешь.

**We swim.** – Мы плаваем.

**They swim.** – Они плавают.

## Образование утвердительного предложения в третьем лице единственного числа

“+” S+V/Vs.

в третьем лице единственного числа к глаголу  
прибавляем окончание **-s**

например: **He swims.** – Он плавает.

**She swims.** – Она плавает.

**It swims.** – Оно плавает.

## Образование утвердительного предложения в третьем лице единственного числа

- to go – goes [gEuz]
- to do – does [dAz]
- to pass – passes (проходить – проходит)
- to teach – teaches (обучать – обучает)
- to push – pushes (толкать – толкает)
- to read – reads [rJdz] (читать – читает)
- to see – sees [sJz] (видеть – видит)
- to fly – flies (летать – летает)

# Мы используем Present Simple

- когда имеем в виду действие, происходящее вообще, не в этот временной момент.

**Parents look after their children** – Родители следят за своими детьми (вообще).

- когда оно происходит постоянно на протяжении долгого промежутка.

**This river meets the Black sea** – Эта река впадает в Черное море (постоянство).

- периодически повторяется.

**I go there every Sunday** – Я хожу туда каждое воскресенье (периодичность).

- ☆ The words **always**, **usually**, **often**, **sometimes**, or **never** show how often things happen.

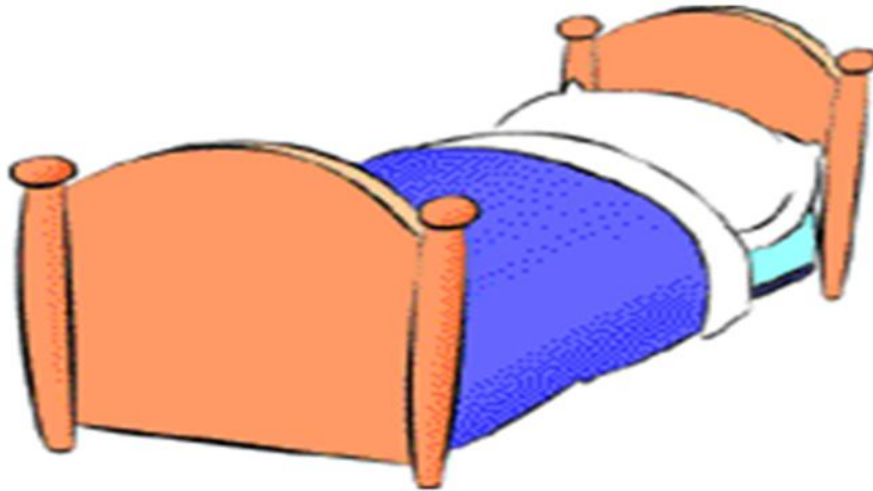
How often	You use ...	Examples
100 %	always	Dad <b>always</b> <b>cooks</b> the dinner.
	usually	Mum <b>usually</b> <b>gets</b> up early.
	often	Cindy <b>often</b> <b>surfs</b> the Net.
50 %	sometimes	Tim <b>sometimes</b> <b>bangs</b> the door.
0 %	never	Bob <b>never</b> <b>goes</b> to school late.
